Second Reading of Ordinance 2004-12

Mr. Mehling completed the second reading of Ordinance 2004-12 *An Ordinance Establishing an Ad Valorem Tax Rate of \$.75 per \$100.00 Assessed Value for Abandoned Urban Property Located in the City of Ludlow, Kentucky and Adopting New Sections to the Ludlow City Code of Ordinances to Effectuate Such Tax Rate.* Owners of abandoned property have until April 1st to appeal the abandoned tax on their property. Discussion the policies and procedures that Mr. Mehling will write for the Code Enforcement Board regarding the tax. Mr. Schroeder stated that the PVA has a period in May when property owners can review the assessments. The abandoned property tax only affects the city taxes, not the county tax rate. **Ms. McMullin motioned to adopt Ordinance 2004-12. Motion seconded by Ms. Schachere. Motion carried: 4 ayes, 0 nays, 2 absent.**
