- State of KY 150 hours Firefighter Training Certificate
- As required a valid CPAT card

The Ludlow Fire Department offers competitive pay. If hired candidates shall obtain their 400 hour KY firefighter training certificate by one calendar year. At that time they will receive KY Firefighter incentive pay. Employees are enrolled in KY state pension. They are also provided with Health insurance, vacation and sick leave pay.
