Fire Department

The Committee recently met with Chief Johnson to discuss the daily operations of the police department and plans for upgrades, training, staffing, and the Neighborhood Watch program. Mr. Wofford accompanied the police during a recent safety walk-through of the school and he plans to accompany the fire department during their walk-through soon.
