SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES

June 12, 2013

Mayor Ken Wynn called the meeting to order at 7:45 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Laurie Sparks called the roll, which showed the following council members present: Tom Amann, Joyce McMullin, Randy Wofford, Bill Mullins, Amy Clary, and Josh Boone.

NEW BUSINESS

Resolution 2013-13

Motion by Mr. Boone, second by Mr. Wofford, to pass Resolution 2013-13 A Resolution of the City of Ludlow, Kentucky Authorizing the Sale or Disposition of Real Property Known as 6 Carneal Street, Ludlow, Kentucky, Pursuant to KRS 82.083. Discussion on the method of disposition for the property. Mayor Wynn advised once the minimum bid amount is determined, they will decide whether to dispose of the property through an auction or sealed bid process. Ms. McMullin inquired how the disposal of the property would serve an economic development purpose. Mr. Richmond advised that once the property is transferred, the City will receive revenue from the taxes collected. **Following the reading of the Resolution by Mr. Richmond and a roll call vote, motion carried: 5 ayes, 1 nay (Ms. McMullin).**

First Reading of Ordinance 2013-3

Motion by Mr. Amann, second by Mr. Mullins, to introduce Ordinance 2013-3 An Ordinance Setting the Budget for the Fiscal Year July 1, 2013 Through June 30, 2014 for the City of Ludlow Calling for Revenue of \$3,253,261.00 and Expenditures of \$3,248,303.94 for a first reading. Mr. Richmond completed the first reading of Ordinance 2013-3 in title only.

First Reading of Ordinance 2013-4

Motion by Mr. Amann, second by Mr. Boone, to introduce Ordinance 2013-4 An Ordinance Amending Section 50.06: Waste Collection Assessments of the Ludlow Code of Ordinances to Establish the Annual Fee for a first reading. Mayor Wynn advised that the City has accepted Rumpke's bid for garbage collection and recycling services at a cost of \$13.00 per unit, per month. The cost includes once a week trash pick up and once a week recycling, with a 65-gallon recycling bin available upon request. The annual cost will be \$10.60 less per unit than the current garbage collection rate. Brett Gaspard of Rumpke addressed questions regarding dual recycling/trash trucks and commercial trash collection. Mr. Gaspard advised that Rumpke will do a mailing to all residents advising them they may request a recycling bin, which is included in the contract, and outlining the collection schedule. The cost of a 96-gallon trash bin is \$103.00 to purchase and \$3.50/month to rent. Mr. Richmond completed the first reading of Ordinance 2013-4.

First Reading of Ordinance 2013-5

Motion by Mr. Amann, second by Mr. Wofford, to amend Ordinance 2013-5 An Ordinance of the City of Ludlow Imposing Regulations and Taxes on Those Engaged in Franchises, Trades, Occupations, Professions and Other Businesses; and Repealing Sections 111.02, 111.03, 111.04, 111.05, 111.05, 111.06, 111.07, 111.08, 111.09, 111.10, 111.11, 111.12 and 111.99 of the City of Ludlow, Kentucky, Code of Ordinances, Chapter 111: Occupational License Tax, Section 111.03 (A) to reduce the Business License Fee from \$100.00 to \$50.00. Following a roll call vote, Motion carried: all ayes. Motion by Mr. Amann, second by Mr. Wofford, to approve Ordinance 2013-5 for a first reading. Mr. Richmond completed the first reading of Ordinance 2013-5 in title only.

Motion by Mr. Amann, second by Mr. Wofford, to adjourn the meeting at 8:15 p.m. Motion carried, all ayes.
