

LUDLOW SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING
MINUTES

July 24, 2014

Mayor Wynn called the meeting to order at 6:50 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Laurie Sparks called the roll, which showed the following council members present: Tom Amann, Joyce McMullin, Randy Wofford, Bill Mullins, and Josh Boone. (Amy Clary was absent.)

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Second Reading of Ordinance 2014-12

Mayor Wynn discussed the ad valorem vehicle tax and the rates currently in effect in several local cities, including Walton (\$.231 per \$100 valuation), Park Hills (\$.334 per \$100 valuation, and Ft. Wright (\$.1977 per \$100 valuation). If the tax rate is set at \$.260 per \$100 valuation, it would generate approximately \$50,000.00 in revenue the first year. The funds would be used to cover the cost of installing a new roof on the Firehouse. Mayor Wynn advised he is still looking into options for collecting the city sticker fee in addition to the ad valorem vehicle tax. Mr. Wofford discussed the issue of violators who live in the city, but don't register their vehicles in Kentucky. **Motion by Mr. Wofford, second by Ms. McMullin, to call up Ordinance 2014-12 An Ordinance Levying the Annual Ad Valorem Tax on Motor Vehicles and Motor Boats and Other Personal Property for City Purposes in the City of Ludlow, Kentucky for a second reading. Following a second reading by Mr. Otis and a roll call vote, motion carried: all ayes.**
