NEW BUSINESS

First Reading of Ordinance 2014-13

Motion by Ms. McMullin, second by Mr. Wofford, to introduce Ordinance 2014-13 *An Ordinance Amending Ludlow City Ordinance No. 2009-3 Allowing for Additional Types of Signage in the City of Ludlow, Kentucky as Proposed by the Text Amendments and Recommendations of the Kenton County Planning Commission. Said Recommendations are Attached Hereto as Exhibit "A" for a first reading.* Mr. Amann expressed concern over the change in the sign regulations to allow a sign up to a maximum of 60 square feet instead of the current maximum of 25 square feet. Discussion on finding out the size of the sign that Ludlow Pharmacy plans to install. Mr. Mullins advised that Katie Litmer of Ludlow Pharmacy indicated that the City would be permitted to use the sign for announcements. After discussion, Ms. McMullin and Mr. Wofford agreed to proceed with the first reading of the ordinance and check with Ludlow Pharmacy to determine the specifications for the proposed sign. **Mr. Johnson completed the first reading of Ordinance 2014-13 noting corrections to the ordinance, including amending Section 1.0 to include adopting Recommendations #1 and #3 from the Kenton County Planning Commission.** Ms. McMullin inquired whether the City could just make an exception to the sign regulations that would allow for this specific project; Mr. Johnson advised he would look into it.

Motion by Ms. McMullin, second by Mr. Mullins, to adjourn the meeting at 12:52 p.m. Motion carried, all ayes.
