

LUDLOW ORDINANCE NO. 2018-2

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING MINI CELL TOWER FRANCHISE FEE. SAID MASTER LICENSE AGREEMENT FOR WIRELESS COMMUNICATIONS FACILITIES IN THE RIGHT-OF-WAY IS ATTACHED HERETO AS EXHIBIT "A."

WHEREAS, the City of Ludlow (the City) is desirous of adopting a mini cell phone tower franchise fee agreement, Said Master License Agreement for Wireless Communications Facilities in the Right-of-Way is attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF LUDLOW, IN KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.0 - Adoption of Agreement

The City hereby adopts the provisions of the Master License Agreement for Wireless Communications Facilities in the right-of-way. Please see the entire agreement attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "A"

Section 2.0 - Provisions Severable

The provisions of this ordinance are severable; and the invalidity of any provision of this ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other provisions thereof; and such other provisions shall remain in full force and effect as long as they remain valid in the absence of those provisions determined to be invalid.

Section 3.0 - Conflicting Ordinances Repealed

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4.0 – Effective Date

This ordinance shall be effective as soon as possible according to law.
