

LUDLOW ORDINANCE 2019 - 16**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LUDLOW, IN
KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AMENDING ORDINANCE 2019-
9 TO PROVIDE A NEW EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, on September 12, 2019, the City of Ludlow adopted Ordinance 2019-9, which increased the license fee on employees from 1.5 percent to 2 percent, and on persons other than employees who engage in business in the City, from .075 percent to .132 percent; and

WHEREAS, under KRS §83A.060, an emergency exists due to the fact that the third-quarter license fee on employees is due October 31 and many employers are likely unaware of the recent adoption of Ordinance 2019-9 and the corresponding rate changes; and

WHEREAS, the City of Ludlow desires to amend Ordinance 2019-9 to provide a new effective date of January 1, 2020 in order to allow for employers to prepare for the corresponding rate changes.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF LUDLOW, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I

That Section IV of Ordinance 2019-9, enacted on September 12, 2019, and relating to the license fee imposed on employees and persons other than employees who engage in any franchise, trade, occupation, profession or other business in the city, is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION IV

1. Shall be published under KRS 83A.060(9) and other applicable law;
2. May be published by summary; and
3. Shall become effective on January 1, 2020.

SECTION II

Any and all ordinances in conflict with this ordinance shall be, and hereby are, repealed to the extent of said conflict.

SECTION III

If any part of this ordinance or its application is deemed invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the City Council intends that such invalidity will not affect the

effectiveness of the remaining provisions or applications and, to this end, the provisions of this ordinance are severable.

SECTION IV

For the reasons set forth above, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and the provisions of this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption by a vote of 2/3 or more of the legislative body. This ordinance may be published by summary.
