



LUDLOW ORDINANCE 2019-8

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LUDLOW, IN KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY, TO CONVERT DAVIES STREET TO A TWO-WAY STREET

WHEREAS, Davies Street in the City of Ludlow is currently a one-way street;

WHEREAS, a recommendation has been made to the City of Ludlow to convert Davies Street to a two-way street;

WHEREAS, under KRS § 178.010(2), the City of Ludlow has the power to regulate and control use of its city streets;

WHEREAS, the City of Ludlow desires to convert Davies Street into a two-way street.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF LUDLOW, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I

Davies Street shall be converted to a two-way street, with traffic flow allowed in both a northbound and southbound direction.

SECTION II

Any and all ordinances in conflict with this ordinance shall be, and hereby are, repealed to the extent of said conflict.

SECTION III

If any part of this ordinance or its application is deemed invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the City Council intends that such invalidity will not affect the effectiveness of the remaining provisions or applications and, to this end, the provisions of this ordinance are severable.

SECTION IV

That this ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and shall be published under KRS §83A.060(9) and other applicable law. This ordinance may be published by summary.
