NEW BUSINESS

Municipal Order 2016-1

Motion by Mr. Whiteley, second by Mr. Boone, to pass Municipal Order 2016-1 A Municipal Order of the City of Ludlow, in Kenton County, Kentucky, Suspending Parking Requirements for New Business as Well as New Business Services Seeking Permit Within the Neighborhood Commercial (NC) Zone to Allow for a Proposed Text Amendment to Add Off-Street Parking Exemptions for Uses Within the NC (Neighborhood Commercial) Zone. Mr. Mullins requested an explanation of the need for the Municipal Order. Ms. Chamberlain advised that under the City's current zoning ordinances, it is not feasible for a new business to comply with the regulations regarding parking. The Municipal Order will temporarily remove the parking restrictions for new businesses that open within the city. **Following a roll call vote, motion carried: all ayes.**
