**AN EXECUTIVE ORDER OF THE MAYOR OF LUDLOW,
KENTUCKY, ENACTED BY THE CITY ADMINISTRATIVE
OFFICER, DECLARING THAT AN EMERGENCY AS A
RESULT OF FLOODING HAS BEEN ISSUED IN
LUDLOW, KENTUCKY**

WHEREAS, Kentucky Revised Statute 39A.100 (2) states that upon written declaration that “the event or occurrence of any of the situations or events contemplated in KRS 39A.010, or 39A.020, which in the judgment of a local Chief Executive Officer is of such severity or complexity as to require the exercise of extraordinary measure the Mayor of a City... may declare in writing that an emergency exists,” and;


WHEREAS, The Mayor has been in communication with the Director of the County of Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management, the City Flood Plain Manager, and the City of Ludlow Fire Chief, and determined that continued flooding warrants a declaration of said emergency in protecting the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Ludlow.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF LUDLOW THAT: An Emergency shall be in effect in Kenton County until said order is reversed, and the Mayor shall take those extraordinary steps necessary to secure the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of Kenton County.

This order shall be enforced and take effect upon signature of CAO as requested by the Mayor of Ludlow, Kentucky.


