

LUDLOW ORDINANCE 2020-8

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LUDLOW, KENTUCKY, DESIGNATING A PORTION OF ELM STREET AS AN "ENTERTAINMENT DESTINATION CENTER" PURSUANT TO 804 KAR 4:370.

WHEREAS, Section 804 KAR 4:370 of the Kentucky Administrative Regulations permits wet cities to designate and establish "entertainment destination centers" within which it is permissible to sell and consume alcoholic beverages within the common areas of that entertainment destination center; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF LUDLOW, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1

That the designation and approval of the entertainment destination center set forth in this Ordinance will aid and promote economic development and tourism within the City of Ludlow.

SECTION 2

That the City hereby designates and approves that portion of Elm Street between Kenner Street and Carneal Street as an entertainment destination center pursuant to 804 KAR 4:370. The geographic boundaries of the entertainment destination center designated herein are more fully described in attached <u>Exhibit A</u> incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 3

The sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages within the common areas of the entertainment destination center shall be permitted in accordance with all requirements and conditions set forth in 804 KAR 4:370. No alcoholic beverages may be taken outside of the geographical boundaries of the said entertainment destination center. All alcoholic beverages shall be sold and consumed in plastic cups to be approved by the City. No alcoholic beverages may be sold or consumed in bottles, glass containers, or metal or aluminum containers.

SECTION 4

All businesses within the entertainment destination center that sells alcoholic beverages shall at all times be properly licensed by the Kentucky Alcoholic Beverage Control Department, and shall comply at all times with all requirements and conditions set forth in 804 KAR 4:370.

SECTION 5

If any part of this ordinance or its application is deemed invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the City Council intends that such invalidity will not affect the effectiveness



of the remaining provisions or applications and, to this end, the provisions of this ordinance are severable.

SECTION 6

That this ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and shall be published under KRS 83A.060(9) and other applicable law. The ordinance may be published by summary.
