

LUDLOW ORDINANCE NO. 2023-2

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LUDLOW, IN KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY, REPEALING THE CITY'S CIVIL SERVICE ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the City previously enacted a Civil Service Ordinance for the purpose of establishing certain requirements and examination procedures for the City's civil services, which are currently set forth in §37.20 through §37.22 of the City's Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the City finds that Chapter 15 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes establishes adequate and necessary qualifications for the City's civil services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF LUDLOW, IN KENTON COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I

That the Ludlow City Council hereby repeals §37.20 through §37.22 of the City's Code of Ordinances. The qualifications and training necessary for the City's civil services shall now be governed by Chapter 15 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes.

SECTION II

All ordinances in conflict with this ordinance shall be, and hereby are, repealed to the extent of said conflict.

SECTION III

If any part of this ordinance or its application is deemed invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the City Council intends that such invalidity will not affect the effectiveness of the remaining provisions or applications and, to this end, the provisions of this ordinance are severable.

SECTION IV

That this ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and shall be published under KRS 83A.060 (9) and other applicable law. The ordinance may be published in summary.
