NEW BUSINESS

First Reading of Ordinance 2021-12

Mayor Boone discussed the need for the budget amendment. The State projected a total cost of \$280,000.00 for the Adela Avenue Paving Project and the lowest bid came in at \$380,000.00. Before the State will award the bid, the City must accept responsibility for the overage. The City can apply for \$25,000.00 in State funds, but only after the project is complete. The City is running out of time because the asphalt mills usually shut down in mid-November. Mayor Boone advised that the City could use the money that was set aside to pave other streets to cover the cost of the project. There may still be enough money to pave Montclair. Using the funds will not impact the money set aside for salt purchases. Mr. McMurtry completed the first reading of Ordinance 2021-12 An Ordinance Amending the Budget for the Fiscal Year July 1, 2021, Through June 30, 2022, for the City of Ludlow Calling for Revenue of \$4,952,983.00 and Expenditures of \$4,175,570.00. Mayor Boone advised that the second reading will be at the special meeting on October 29, 2021, at 6:00 p.m.
