UNFINISHED BUSINESS

First Reading of Ordinance 2021-7

Mayor Boone advised that since the first reading of Ordinance 2021-7 at the meeting on August 12, 2021, Fischer Homes contacted the City and advised that 290 would be the lowest number of apartment units that would allow them to continue with the development. Because the change in the number of units would be significant compared to the 200 units approved in the first reading, a new first reading will need to be held if Council approves. Following discussion, motion by Mr. Chapman, second by Ms. Grider, to have the first reading of Ordinance 2021-7 An Ordinance of the City of Ludlow, in Kenton County, Kentucky, Approving Grand Communities, LLC's Request for a Map Amendment with a change in the condition in Section I that would allow up to 300 apartment units. Mr. Taylor completed the first reading of Ordinance 2021-7, with the changes.
